

Planned Use of Highfield South Farnham Sports Premium 2017-18

Purpose of funding

Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

How Highfield South Farnham is planning to use the Sports Premium Funding:

Development	Cost	Impact
Continuous monitoring, replenishment and updating of sports equipment to support teaching and learning in PE.	£2,000	Children have access to a range of quality equipment to develop their abilities and skills in PE.
Sports Association subscription	£120	Network of schools providing a wide range of sporting opportunities in which children can participate.
Provision of teacher release for continued CPD opportunities in PE	£3000	Up to date knowledge and understanding of the PE curriculum for all staff. Working with staff to further develop their skills of planning and assessing PE. Further development of opportunities for staff to observe experienced members of staff teaching PE. To embed PE expertise amongst all teaching staff.
Provision of transport to enable children to further access a range of sporting fixtures and events, including the provision of a coach to District Sports.	£500	Increased opportunities for children to take part in sporting fixtures and tournaments, district sports and swimming gala
Contribution towards outdoor multi-use games area	£12,340	Provision of a facility that can provide the opportunity to enjoy sport and PE throughout the year and will enable the school to participate in additional inter-school sporting competitions
