What we offer...

The Nursery is housed in a large purpose-built structure with an extensive outdoor area which is securely fenced.

The Nursery setting offers different sessions which are listed below. The nursery can hold 48 children. Children attend a minimum of 18hrs a week, 15 of which are government funded sessions. We also accept spaces of 30 hour government funded childcare If you choose for your child to attend for a full day or an extended day we are able to provide a healthy, well balanced school dinner and the school office will be happy to confirm costs.

Children will be admitted into Nursery in the term after their 3rd birthday. Please complete an application form if you wish to be added to the waiting list for the next term's entry.
